She applied to the Office for the Aging's Weatherization Referral and Packaging Program (WRAP), who in turn contacted North Country Energy \$mart Communities. Mrs. Sharpe's income qualified her for Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR, a program of the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), which pays half the cost of approved energy efficiency measures up to a maximum grant of \$5,000.

A Building Performance Institute (BPI) Accredited Contractor conducted a Comprehensive Home Assessment and a work scope was agreed upon. Additional financial and material support came from the Ministry in the North Country Rural Rehab, CDP Ogdensburg Neighborhood Center Care and Share Program, St. Vincent De Paul, Catholic Charities, USDA-Rural Development, NYSERDA's EmPower New YorkSM Program, St. Lawrence Gas and Enbridge Services, and Windo-therm, LLC. Mrs. Sharpe paid the maximum required homeowner contribution of \$500.
